

Diversey Yacht Club House Rules

- 1. Members shall remain orderly at all times while on the premises and shall be fully responsible for the proper conduct of their children and their guests.
- 2. Guests shall not include non-member resident boat owners at Diversey Harbor.
- 3. Do not litter. Remove, or dispose of, all personal trash from clubhouse and facilities.
- 4. Dogs and other pets are not allowed in the Yacht Club.
- 5. Children in the Club under twelve (12) years old must be always accompanied by an adult. Children shall not be allowed in the Club after 11pm.
- 6. For the convenience of members, notices may be posted on the bulletin board and/or website.
- 7. Outside food and alcoholic beverages are not to be brought into the club, unless agreed upon in writing with the Board and food and beverage directors.
- 8. Members damaging club property will be liable for same.
- 9. Furniture, fixtures, and decorations are not to be removed from the premises. This includes, but is not limited to, indoor and outdoor chairs and tables, coolers, tablecloths, utensils, barware, flags, etc.
- 10. Private parties are not permitted in the clubhouse. Permission from the DYC Board must be obtained at least one week prior to a private party. The club shall remain open to members during all private parties.
- 11. Members are required to wear appropriate attire, such as shoes and shirts, at all times while on the premises. Cover ups must be worn over swimwear at all times.
- 12. Associate members may not bring more than five (5) guests into the Club at a time unless they have received written approval in advance from the DYC Board.
- 13. As with all city of Chicago liquor licenses, no smoking or vaping in the club at any time.

Additional rules and regulations may apply to your membership as approved by the Board of Directors.
